



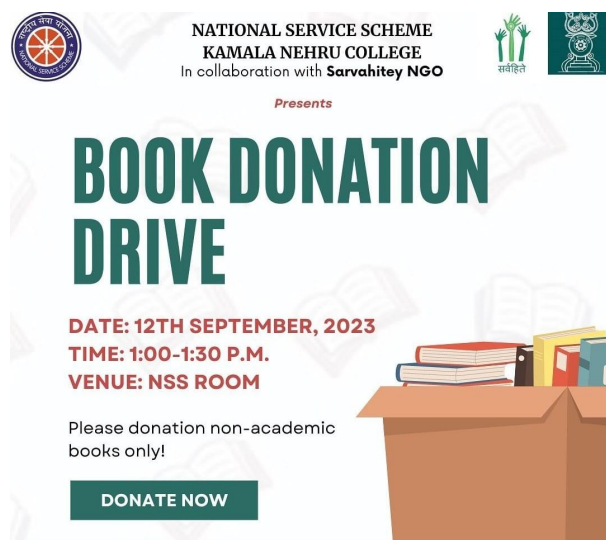
# NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME

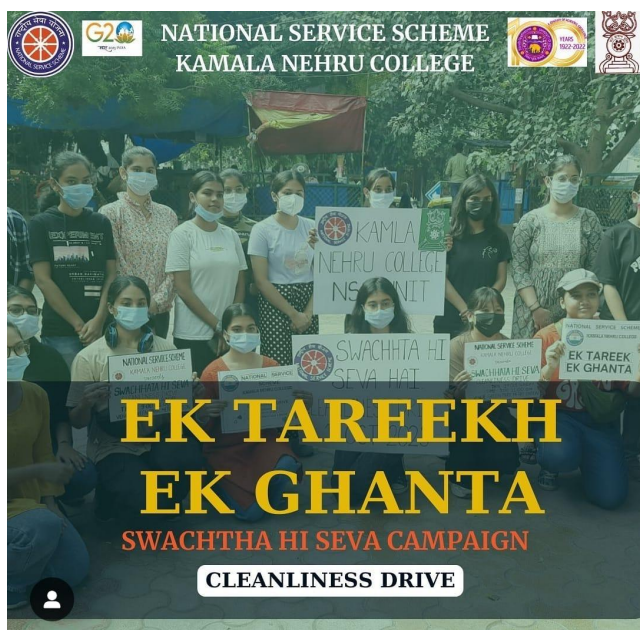
