### AUGUST EVENTS

The month of August saw 3 events, first being - the Independence Day celebration honoured with a pledge taking ceremony and a flag hoisting event as a ceremonial act to honour the nation. The second was the orientation program organised on 25th August 2023. Here in, students were introduced to the purpose of NSS and were encouraged to join the NSS. # From NSS RLAC, 2 volunteers - Muskan Mohindroo (6th position) and Harshdev Singh (9th position) took part in the Red Run. Under the joint aegis of DDWS & MoHUA for the Swachh Bharat Diwas, NSS RLAC arranged 4 cleanliness drives between 18th to 25th September alongside a pledge taking ceremony on16th September. 70 volunteers swore to devote 100 hours to social service, encourage 100 individuals to take pledge and devote 100 hours for cleanliness. An online essay writing competition was organised on 23rd September.





October was phenomenal due to the conclusion of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav by 'Meri Maati Mera Desh' events. The Unit organised events while actively participating in the Amrit KalashYatra and other events organised by the Central Government. The concluding one being on the Kartavya Path on 31st October 2023. The opening event was 'Ek Tareekh Ek Ghanta', in which 60 volunteers engaged themselves in a onehour Shramdaan as a part of the 'Swachhata Hi Sewa Campaign'. On the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti, an Online Poster Making Competition was organised on the theme 'Gandhi's Idea of Swachh Bharat.'





On 3rd October, a Plog Run was organised to emphasise on fitness. It was a run from the college to Moti Bagh. From October 9, a three-day Kalash Yatra was organised to promote national unity and integrity. On the 1st day, volunteers were requested to submit a fistful of rice. The 2nd and 3rd days saw rallies being conducted from the college to the South Campus Pink Police Booth and to the residence of an ex-MLA of RK Puram. This yatra was carried out with two kalash one having maati and other, rice. On 10th October itself, a session on Mental Health Awareness was organised with Mr. Jayant Sundaresan, consultant psychologist at Qurex being the guest speaker. To contribute towards eliminating hunger, the volunteers helped at the Vedanta Half Marathon on October 14th.







The Unit also organised an Education Camp from 16th to 20 th October. The volunteers went to JJ Colony, Moti Bagh and taught different topics/subjects to the children. On October 21st, Police Commemoration Day was celebrated with collection and distribution of heartwarming handwritten letters written to our heroes.
